Getting Started: Transferring Your Prescription

ENROLL IN THE SPECIALTY PHARMACY PROGRAM.

ACCESS TO A PHARMACIST 24/7.

Our specialty pharmacists are available 24/7 and will take care of everything for you, including:

- Transferring your prescription to a specialty pharmacy
- Helping you find affordable access to your medication and manage any side effects
- Explaining how the Specialty Pharmacy Program works

PERSONALIZED SUPPORT.

Once you enroll, experience personalized, one-on-one support from pharmacists and nurses specially trained in your disease condition as part of the Clinical Management Programs for certain specialty conditions. They will track your progress, help you maintain your therapy and answer your questions.



Working with Your Pharmacist or Nurse

CONTINUED CONVERSATIONS.

Tell your pharmacist or nurse about any changes or complications in your therapy, such as:

- Any side effects

QUICK AND EASY REFILLS.

With your specialty pharmacy, shipping your medication is quick, easy and safe. Refrigerated medications will be delivered overnight directly to your home or office, in a temperature-controlled package. Others will be shipped within 1-3 days. Supplies will also be provided at no extra cost.
