

Is there a specific frame selection that I must to choose from?


No! Avesis members can select any frame from a participating provider's selection. Frames that fall within the member's plan allowance are covered in full.

How To Use Your Benefits

When you need to see an eye care professional, simply call Avesis, Monday through Friday, 5AM to 6PM (MST) at 1-888-211-4012 or visit www.avesis.com/maricopa. Avesis' Customer Service Representatives and its website have the most current listing of participating providers.

1. Select a Participating Provider
2. Call and identify yourself as an Avesis member
3. Schedule an appointment
4. Present your ID Card and pay any co-pays or charges not covered under the vision plan

Out-of-Network Information

Members who elect to use an out-of-network provider must pay the provider in full at the time of service and submit a claim to Avesis for reimbursement.
